- ❑ Strongest hurricane to hit ever the Bahamas.
- ❑ Category 5 winds in excess of 185 mph for 48 hours.
- ❑ Entire communities were destroyed in the Abaco Islands and on Grand Bahama Island with thousands of people needing shelter and aid.
- ❑ 45 confirmed deaths
