Hurricane Dorian

- ❑ One of the longest named storms in the Atlantic – it became a named storm Aug. 24 and dissipated Sept. 7.
- ❑ Made five separate landfalls – three in the Bahamas, one in North Carolina and one in Nova Scotia.
- ❑ 50 deaths in the Bahamas.
- ❑ Five deaths in the U.S.
- ❑ 1,300 people still missing in the Bahamas

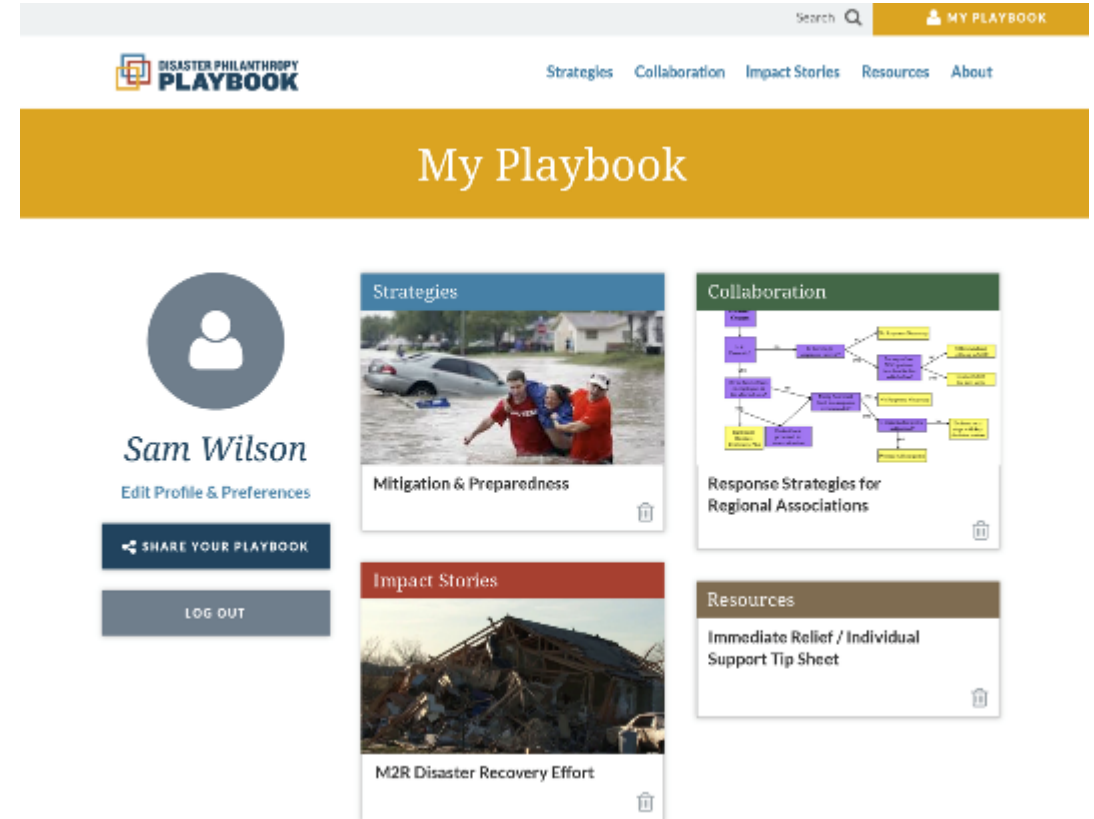
